<b>POD-type</b>	<p>1 per residence for 1 year after declared disaster unless extended by Council.</p> <p>Allowed for 2 weeks during moving.</p>	<p>Any number for warehousing facility (SIC Code 4225) provided an 8-foot opaque fence screens containers from the street and mini-warehouses are located on the property.</p> <p>No more than two for any other business.</p> <p>Allowed for two weeks while moving.</p> <p>No stacking of containers.</p> <p>Must be used for on-site storage only and not leased or sold for off-site storage.</p>
<b>Conex-type</b>	<p>Not allowed.</p>	<p>Any number for warehousing facility (SIC Code 4225) provided an 8-foot fence screens containers from the street and mini-warehouses are located on the property.</p> <p>No more than two for any other business.</p> <p>No stacking of containers.</p> <p>Must be used for on-site storage only and not leased or sold for off-site storage.</p>
