

**CITY OF ORANGE**  
**CDBG-DR APPLICATION PROJECT SUMMARY**  
**SANITARY SEWER LINE REHABILITATION**

Project Description:

During Tropical Storm Imelda, the City of Orange received between 15 and 18 inches of rainfall. Widespread flooding led to massive I & I of the wastewater collection system, as well as backup and overflow of raw sewage throughout the City. This influx of groundwater resulted in disruptions to service, an inability to flush toilets, environmental hazards and other threats to public health and safety.

The proposed improvements will reduce a risk to public health and safety for residents of the Roselawn neighborhood in the City of Orange.

Construction will consist of the improvements to the Westway Street sewer lines and Lilac Street sewer lines.
