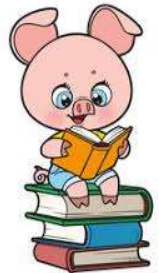

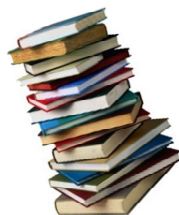
## ***Volunteer***
